## Beulahland(for ages 0-3)

Featured in the New York Times and the Boston Globe, Beulahland is a class for infants and toddlers and their caregivers. Besides music and singing, Beulahland curriculum is designed to help the young develop a visual vocabulary of faith. It not only teaches children particular Bible stories, but also opens the whole world of Scripture and liturgy to the child's imagination.



## Godly Play(for ages 3-9)

is a Montessori-based curriculum designed to teach children the art of religious language - parable, sacred story, silence, and liturgical action - to help interpret the events of their daily lives. Multi-sensory materials encourage children to enter into the stories and relate to them.

## Scripture Study (for ages 9-12)

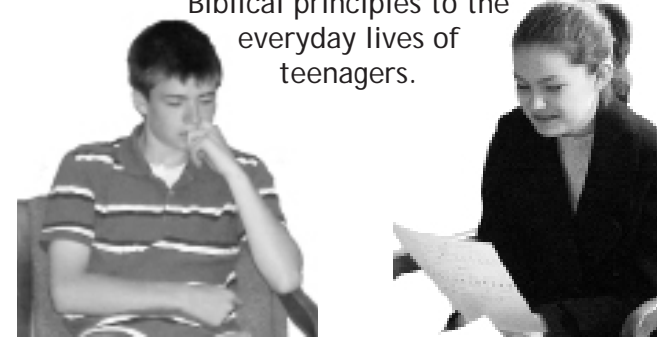
teaches the story of God's salvation by looking closely at the Bible, from Genesis to Revelation.
